## **Financial Support**

If you are finding it difficult to manage in the current economic climate. Please see the following information for support options available:

Household support fund: Those who are not eligible for a cost of living payment from DWP in October /November 2023 may be eligible for a grant from the household support fund. Anyone in Essex is able to apply to the fund and can contact the Peabody team for financial support with the cost of living. Essential Living Fund: Grants for support with food, hygiene products and fuel payments, for items of furniture or one off purchases. Social Prescribing: For those who would like to make positive change to their health and wellbeing, a social prescriber can support with a range of non-medical circumstances. Including: *Keeping Active*- Wellness walks, seated exercise, weight management programmes. *Practical support*- Help into employment, dementia and carer support, advice on slips, trips, and falls, Food bank referrals and vouchers, food support. Essex family support service. *Connecting with others*- social groups and activities, befriending and volunteering opportunities.
