Keeping Safe

Please help us to keep you and your children safe by driving and parking sensibly. The car park is for staff at the infant and junior schools only and for parents/carers with disabled badges. It is a small car park and can become blocked very easily. We also ask that you do not park in front of the school gates, unless it has been agreed with the school for a particular reason. There is restricted parking outside of the school gates so do not stop on yellow lines during pick up or drop off. All vehicles parking in restricted areas will be reported to the parking authorities and may face prosecution.

Year 1 and 2 should have brought home letters for after school clubs. If you wish your child to attend any of these clubs, please complete forms and place in a named envelope with any payment and return to the school office. Thank you.
