The PTFA exists to raise extra funds to help improve the equipment and resources that enhance our children's education. We aim to hold various events over the school year that bring together pupils, parents, staff, friends and the wider community alike, in support of both schools. Our continued goal is to make our events inclusive and engaging.

This year our committee helped incorporate new ideas to the main events and see if fresher ideas improved profits from the previous year. New members joined who brought ideas, enthusiasm, determination and hard work which helped us have another successful and profitable year.

We have continued engaging with the local businesses, including being contacted by stallholders for pitches, assistance with advertising and promotion of events (estate agent boards) and offers of donations.
