Parents and carers of children in year 2 have been sent an email and need to respond by 1.00pm on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June. If we do not hear from you, we will assume you do not want your child to take up this offer. I am sorry that I cannot offer this to all of our families but we do not have the space in school to facilitate this.
