## **Covid Testing**

Please do <u>not</u> send your child to school if they display any of the following symptoms:

#### High temperature New/persistent cough Loss of taste or smell

If your child has any symptoms of covid, book a test immediately and notify school. Your child must stay home until you have the results. If they test positive your child and all members of your household must stay home and follow NHS guidance. Please notify school of any positive tests. If the test is negative, notify school and your child may return immediately.

### PE Days

We are still encouraging children to wear PE kits on their PE days to avoid having to change in class. Please ensure your child wears their rocket tshirt and shorts. They may wish to wear a track suit which should be plain black or blue. If they do not have a suitable sweat shirt they should wear their school jumper. Do not send children in to school with logos and designs on clothing or in super hero costumes. Thank you.

#### Jewellery

Jewellery, apart from watches and stud earrings, should not to be worn in school. All children must remove studs before doing PE. Staff are not allowed to remove them for the children. Children are not permitted to wear nail varnish in school.


## **Road Safety**
