How would you change the world if you could?

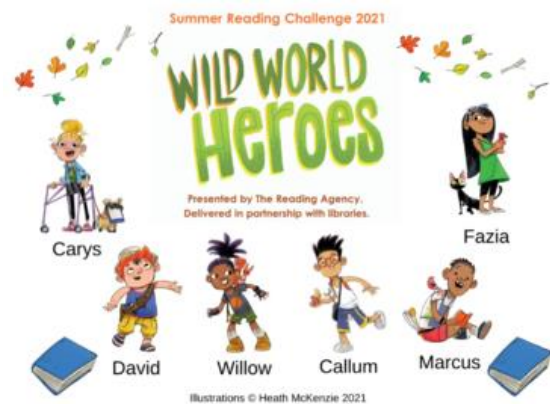
Sun Safe School
