School Council

Reps will attend regular meetings with Mrs Farr to discuss ways we can improve the school. Reps also deliver assemblies and teach their class important skills like how to cross the road safely. Please talk to your child to see if they would like to stand for election. If they do, they will need to prepare a short presentation on why they would be a great class rep. They will present these to their own class on Monday 20th September and then the class will vote for the new reps. This will be open to year 1 and 2 to start. Reception will be included in the spring term.

Information Sharing

We always have lots of information to share with parents and carers on a regular basis. Teachers use Tapestry in nursery and reception to share information about school and your child's learning. In years 1 and 2 we use Class Dojo. Please ensure you have logged on to these and get involved with your child's learning. Any difficulties, talk to your child's class teacher who will be happy to help. As a school we also use Arbor to send out and request information and it is also where you may book and pay for clubs, including breakfast club. Please make sure you have enabled push

notifications on your device to be able to receive messages.

Individual Photos

All children will have their photo taken in school next Friday. They will also have a photo taken with their brother or sister during the day if they are also in this school. If you would like their photo taken with a sibling at the juniors or pre-school children, please go on to Arbor to express an interest.
