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To ensure consistency and progression in PE lessons across the school.	CPD for staff on teaching core skills and understanding progression of skills in lessons. Work with PE coach to develop a scheme of work that teaches and develops the fundamental skills.			
To increase physical activity through a range of new experiences and opportunities and intra-house competition.	To organise circus skills and skipping workshops to inspire children to be more active. Ensure enough resources available so children are able to repeat skills taught in workshops. To arrange in house competitions to encourage healthy competition and activity during lunch and break time.	£1,200		
To increase physical activity throughout the school.	To reintroduce the Golden mile. Purchase resources to help children know when they have completed the correct number of laps around the playground. Star of the day step counter watches x10 to encourage the children to be active and compare with each other and beat their own step count.	£250		
To increase physical challenge on the playground.	To extend the current climbing wall in the front playground with a section that increases the challenge for children. The section requires a piece that sticks out from the wall that children have to negotiate. This will require good upper body strength and control.	£3,000
