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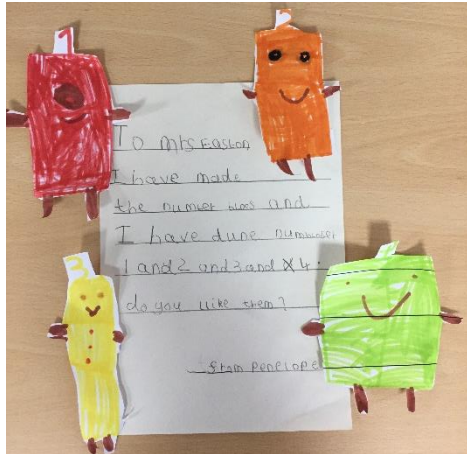
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writing to Mrs Giant and to Mr Wrench to find out more.
