- Writing for different purposes, including stories and postcards.

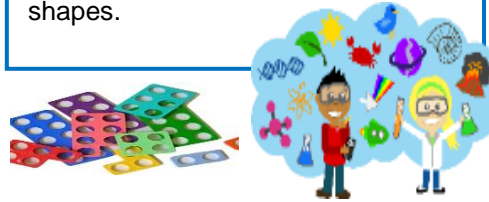
In Phonics, we will recap phase 3 and 4 and begin to learn phase 5, working on blending and segmenting skills.
