We will be sharing lots of stories with the children and introducing new vocabulary as it occurs. We will introduce 'stem sentences' in all areas of the curriculum to encourage the children to speak in full

We will have lots of discussions with the children, giving them opportunities to talk about their likes, dislikes, interests and families. We will introduce the Class Cuddle and Show & Tell.

We will play lots of listening games and discuss ways that we can show how we are listening.

Physical Development

We are lucky to have such a fantastic outdoor environment that the children have lots of time to access throughout the day. We will be teaching the children to use all of the equipment safely.

As we begin PE lessons we will teach the children about the rules they should follow in PE to keep them safe. We will be teaching children spatial awareness and begin to introduce ball skills including throwing and catching.

Lots of what we do will help to support children's fine and gross motor skills. As well as developing their large muscle groups, we will also experiencing lots of fine motor activities such as dough disco, which will in turn support pencil control as they begin writing.
