Great Bradfords Infant & Nursery School Behaviour Principles Written Statement

Rationale

The Education and Inspectors Act 2006 and **DfE** guidance (**Behaviour** in Schools, 2022) requires the Governors to make and frequently review, a **written statement** of general **behaviour principles** to guide the Headteacher in determining measures to promote good **behaviour**. This is a **statement of principles**, not practice.

Aims

We aim to provide a safe and stimulating environment in which children and adults live the values, which we hold at the heart of our school.

We strive for a climate in which children and adults feel happy and are able to flourish.

To achieve this goal, we recognise the need to have a whole school approach to the management of behaviour.

In order to achieve our aims we shall strive to ensure that each member of staff and every child in our school community understands:

- Our acceptable standards of behaviour;
- The positive rewards to both support and to celebrate good behaviour;
- The possible sanctions given if our codes of conduct are broken;
- The support systems that are available for those requiring extra help;
- That the behaviour policy is understood by pupils and staff;
- That the behaviour policy is easily available for parents to enable them to have the opportunity to learn our systems, expectations and aspirations for behaviour;
- That all pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination;
- That we expect staff, volunteers and parents on site to set an excellent example to pupils at all times;
- That pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions, with the encouragement or correcting behaviour accordingly if necessary.
