Mathematics

Pupils will be focusing on the following areas:

Place value of numbers within 20 (Spring 1) and 50 (Spring 2).

- Counting forwards and backwards within 20 (Spring 1) and 50 (Spring 2).
- Recognise and write numbers as numerals and words
- Addition and subtraction within 20.
- Compare and measure length, height, weight and volume.
