




Mathematics





- Solving multiplication and division problems.
- Position and direction, including left, right, clockwise and anticlockwise.
- Measuring mass, capacity and temperature using the appropriate units (g/kg, ml/l, °C)
- Telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes.
- Measuring length and height in metres and centimetres.

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Music

In Music we will be focusing on pitch, pulse, tempo, rhythm and dynamics through singing and listening to songs that make us feel happy.

Science

In Science we will be learning about the following areas...

- Observing how seeds and bulbs grow into plants
- Investigating what plants need to grow and stay healthy

- Working scientifically asking questions, making observations, grouping and classifying, performing simple tests




PSHE

Our work in PSHE this term will focus on 'Relationships' and 'Changing me'. We will learn about: 🔳



History & Geography


In History our topic is What is a Monarch? where we will be learning about...
