# **Term Time Holidays**

We are receiving an increasing number of requests for term time holidays. Please note, schools are not permitted to authorise holidays during term time. No holiday will be authorised and by taking a holiday you may be open to a fixed penalty notice from Essex County Coucil.

#### Don't Be Late

Please ensure children arrive on time for school in the morning. Doors open at 8.40am and close at 8.50am. If you child arrives after this time they will be marked as late in the register. Registers close at 9.20am. Any children arriving after this time will have a unauthorised absence mark in the register. They will be marked as present on our fire register for obvious safety reasons. You can

see attendance information for your child on Arbor. The target for individual and whole school attendance is 95%. Routine dental and optician appointments should be made outside of school hours.
