During the autumn term, we will be using the 'That's Not My...' stories, and 'Handa's Surprise' and 'Handa's Hen' by Eileen Browne. We will be writing stories, colour poems and reports.

We will be focusing on letter formations and sentence construction using nouns, verbs and adjectives.

In Phonics, we will recap phase 3 and 4 and begin to learn phase 5, working on blending and segmenting skills.



Mathematics



The children will be focusing on the following areas:

- -Number place value within 10, including one more than and one less than.
- -Counting forwards and backwards within 10.
- Addition and subtraction within 10.
- Geometry: Naming 2D and 3D shapes.

- How religious festivals bring communities together (Christmas/Eid)

During the autumn term, we will be:

- Introducing beat by exploring pulse and rhythm.
- Exploring high and low pitch sounds.

Science

During the first half term, we will be learning about the parts of the body and the five senses.

In the second half term, we will be comparing and grouping animals based on similarities and differences in their characteristics, physical features and diets.



Art & Design

This term, we will be focusing on drawing skills. We will explore different ways of using line and shape in a range of media. We will find out about the artist Paul Klee.

We will learn about colour mixing and apply this within printing and painting. We will be designing plates in the style of Clarice Cliff.


