



English



During the autumn term, we will be using the 'That's Not My...' stories, 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' by Michael Rosen and 'Pigs Might Fly' by Jonathan Emmett. We will be writing stories, colour poems and postcards.

We will be focusing on letter formation and sentence construction using nouns, verbs and adjectives.

In Phonics, we will recap phase 3 and 4 and begin to learn phase 5, working on blending and segmenting skills.

Mathematics



The children will be focusing on the following areas:

- Number place value within 10, including one more than and one less than.
- Counting forwards and backwards within 10.
- Addition and subtraction within 10.
- Geometry: Naming 2D and 3D shapes.

RE



We will explore:

- How the senses are engaged in religion and worship (Hindu-Puja)
- How religious festivals bring communities together (Christmas/Eid)

Science

During the first half term, we will be naming the four seasons and learning about seasonal changes in terms of weather and how the trees change.

In the second half term, we will be learning about everyday items and the materials they are made from. We will be describing materials by their properties



Music



During the autumn term, we will be:

- Introducing beat by exploring pulse and rhythm.
- Exploring high and low pitch sounds.



Art & Design

This term, we will be focusing on drawing skills. We will explore different ways of using line and shape in a range of media. We will find out about the artist Paul Klee.

We will learn about colour mixing and apply this within printing and painting. We will be designing plates in the style of Clarice Cliff.

The PSHE topics this term are:

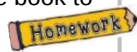
- Being me in my world

PE

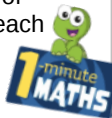
